Chamber Committees

The Chamber's five standing committees serve as the conduit to addressing the needs of our business community. Volunteer-led, these committees are open to all individual members and employees of Chamber member businesses.	
Ag & Natural Resources	This committee promotes and supports agriculture and natural resources through the 4-H Buyer's Reception, natural resources education and agricultural forums.
Business Retention & Expansion	Helping local businesses succeed is paramount to our mission. The BRE Committee focuses on workforce training, roundtables and professional development to help you succeed.
Government Affairs	This committee provides a conduit for ideas and information regarding public policies to flow between members, local municipalities and elected officials.
